## WHAT ARE YOU HEARING?



### ADDRESSING YOUR QUESTIONS

- Can we go "vertical" on the High School or Elementary/Middle School?
  - We are not able to go vertical on 'original' section of HS or 1-8 bldg.
- Can we fit a K-12 campus on the 46-acre site?
  - Recommended acreage for the current High School is 33.33 acres
  - Recommended acreage for the current Middle School is 22.45 acres
  - Recommended acreage for the current Elementary School is 13.87 acres
  - Total recommended acreage for a K-12 campus (not including athletic fields) is nearly 70 acres
  - Current acreage of Elementary/Middle & High School campus is 37.7 acres
- What are the current enrollments and capacities of each school?
  - Please reference the print outs at your tables

## POTENTIAL OPTIONS

#### KEY ASSUMPTIONS

- Capital maintenance projects will be evaluated separately from options
- Future use of Arlington is yet to be determined
  - Close building
  - Sell property
  - Repurpose for District use
- Community space(s) within any renovations/additions/new construction is yet to be determined
- In typical facility planning, the cost of a High School building is greater than the cost of an Elementary School building

- Improve student circulation (ES / MS and between HS)

- Renovate existing Elementary / Middle School to become EC, K 5
   Elementary School
- Build new Middle School (6 8)
- Renovate existing High School (9-12)

- Renovate existing Elementary / Middle School to become EC, K 4
   Elementary School
- Renovate existing High School to become 5 8 School
- Build new High School (9 12)

Connect Elementary / Middle School to High School & create an
 EC, K-12 Campus on the existing site

# QUESTIONS

#### COMMITTEE CHARGE

The Board of Education of the School District of Poynette authorizes the creation of a Community Facility Advisory Committee (Committee) to be charged with the task of seeking solutions to our District's facility needs. The Committee is charged to review all pertinent information found in the District's completed Facilities Assessment. The Board desires the following to be considered by the Committee in making a facility recommendation to the Board of Education for future action:

- Options should reflect the **District's mission** and **goals**
- Options should include purposeful spaces to inspire 21st Century learning, accommodate evolving technology and promote collaboration
- Options may include **new construction**, **renovations**, **repurposed spaces**, and/or **upgrades** to support learning environments
- Options should include spaces for students, staff, parents, and community
- Options should be **cost-effective** for taxpayers, energy efficient and adaptable for future use
